* H.U.M.A.N.E. Education:

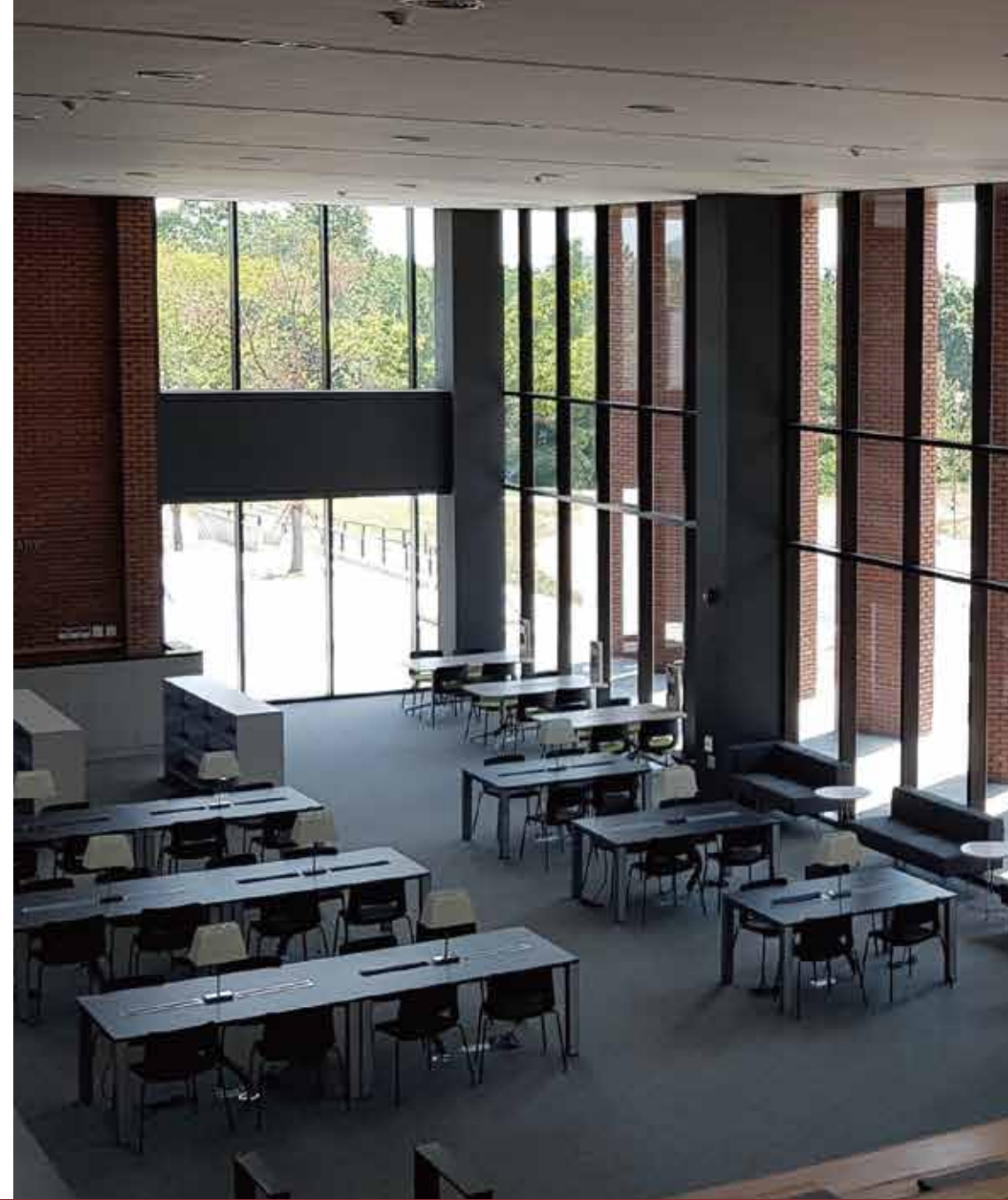
'H' stands for honesty, integrity & responsibility;

In order to achieve its **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**, the UN emphasized Global Citizenship Education as a cross-cutting issue.

In response, Handong Global University and UN Academic Impact Korea established **IGE**. Based on the essence of 20-year experiences of holistic and global education by Handong Global University, IGE offers **Holistic Global Citizenship Program (HGCP)** to global leaders from all around the world.

The courses offered by IGE's Holistic Global Citizenship Program is co-operated with the School of Creative Convergence Education at Handong Global University. Each domain of **"H.U.M.A.N.E."** education is offered with 6 core courses (18 credits). The program focuses on the UN's 17 Sustainable Development Goals with the perspective of holistic global citizen mindset and create global leaders with capacities through various problem-solving practices.

Networking for Our Future Survival: Sustainable Development and Environment

Learn about environmental sustainability and development for sustainable development

Discuss about technologies and strategies to improve sustainability, especially focusing on urbanization issues

This course aims to understand environmental degradation, which is one of the biggest threats that hinders the achievement of UN's SDGs, and focuses on critical thinking to create ways to foster a sustainable development for environmental sustainability.

With the understanding of sustainable environmental development, students will be navigated to find answers for sustainable development by balanced critical thinking.

Furthermore, students will review and discuss smart technologies, urban design and planning, policies, and development strategies that can bring dramatic improvements in urban livability and sustainability.

Understand the definition, realm, issues of global citizenship education and design curriculums and build capacities through case studies and practices

Education for Global Citizenship

This course presents the skills that are needed in order to live as a global citizen that are drawn from GCED's domain, contents, issues, and curriculum design and strategy. It furthermore increases the capacity and competitiveness as a global citizen by incorporating case studies and in class practices.

Students will actively incorporate content from the course into their personal global citizenship education program, curriculum design, lesson plan, and in-class practices.
